DEDUCTIONS FORM THE DONATIONS

Terms of deductions

1. Physical person

According to article 15 of law 8 on tax

For an individual person the total tax deductable is 2%. The minimum tax base is 1000Kc. The maximum deductable is 10%.

2. <u>Employees</u>

According to article 20 law 8

Am employee may deduct no higher than 5% and the minimum donation is 2000Kc. This deduction cannot be paid by the tax payer who isn't based in an enterprise.
